

Demand Load Management Program

AEC offers a **Demand Load Management Program (DLM)** to its commercial consumers to help curtail demand charges of individual accounts by controlling usage during peak time periods. During this year's peak season (June 20 to Sept. 9, excluding July 4, Sept. 5, and all Sundays), **Peak Hours will be between 4:00 pm and 6:00 pm Central Daylight Savings Time.**

All commercial accounts get billed a demand charge of \$8.40/KW. This DLM Program allows commercial accounts to receive a \$6.00/KW credit to curtail their loads from 4:00pm to 6:00pm on peak days called by AEC's power supplier WFEC. This program allows DLM accounts to run 22 hours a day on peak days and 24 hours a day on all other days.

Western Farmers Electric Cooperative (WFEC) will continue to provide AEC notification of when WFEC is calling a peak day during the DLM season. AEC's members have the flexibility of calling our main office daily or signing up to receive a text message to see if running during the peak time is permitted. Members can call toll free at 888-736-3837 and ask for extension #123, or for a quicker response call 580-366-4582 x123 and a recorded message will tell members whether or not it is a peak day.

All DLM accounts will be responsible for paying a \$40 annual meter read fee. This fee will be added to your January billing statement.
